Letter of Agreement

Between

Egyptian Association for International Medical Studies
Kasr Alainy Medical School, Faculty of Medicine, Cairo University - Egypt

And

Sumandeep Vidyapeeth (Deemed University) - India

For bilateral cooperation in the years 2017, 2018 and 2019.

Whereas, the parties desire to enter into this agreement for bilateral cooperation for the purpose of development and dissemination of medical knowledge, the Egyptian Association for International Medical Studies, further on referred to as EAIMS and the Sumandeep Vidyapeeth (Deemed University), further on referred to as SV, therefore agree:

I. On the Undergraduate Level:

- (1) Each year, both institutions may exchange up to:
- 4 students from Human Medicine,
 - 4 students from Dental Medicine,
 - 4 students from allied health sciences including Physiotherapy, Pharmacy, Nursing and Hospital and Public Health Management.
- for a clinical clerkship/training maximum for 4 weeks consisting of 5 days a week and 2 days weekend, beginning with the academic year 2017. Whereas EAIMS provides placements at Kasr Alainy University Hospital and/or other affiliated Institutes of Cairo University, the SV provides placements at its University Hospital and/or other affiliated Institutes of Sumandeep Vidyapeeth.
- (2) Available fields: At Kasr Alainy Hospital all fields are available. At SV, the following fields are available:

- (3) Registration, Tuition Fees & Expenses: Students will continue to be registered as per rules and criteria stipulated at their home university. Nominated students do not have to pay any tuition fees to their host institution. The incoming students are responsible for provision of any necessary insurance coverage, all expenses for insurance, travel, board and lodging, and other miscellaneous expenses as well as meeting all requirements associated with obtaining visa for the hosting country.
- (4) Calendar: EAIMS prefers to receive undergraduate candidates in 1 or 2 groups all over the year except in Ramadan time, whereas SV prefers to receive undergraduate candidates during all the months except Dipawali holidays.
- (5) Accommodation: Both parties will assist in locating suitable housing for the incoming students. However, the parties are not responsible for any costs arising from accommodation. However, for incoming students to SV, accommodation at University Guest House/Hostel shall be arranged on request as per policy of University.
- (6) Certificate: At the end of clerkship/training, the students will receive a confirmation of the clinical clerkship/training at the host institution if they have at least 80% attendance.

II. On the Postgraduate Level:

- (7) Each year, both institutions may exchange up to:
- 4 postgraduate candidates from Human Medicine,
 - 4 postgraduate candidates from Dental Medicine,
 - 4 postgraduate candidates from allied health sciences including Physiotherapy, Pharmacy, Nursing and Healthcare Management.
- for a clinical clerkship/training maximum for 4 weeks consisting of 5 days a week and 2 days weekend, beginning with the academic year 2017. Whereas EAIMS provides placements at Kasr Alainy University Hospital and/or other affiliated Institutes of Cairo University, the SV provides placements at its University Hospital and/or other affiliated Institutes of Sumandeep Vidyapeeth.
- (8) Training: The postgraduate candidates will receive training by observing patient treatment and by observing research on the respective departments under the supervision of the hosting institution physicians.
- (9) Available fields: At Kasr Alainy Hospital all fields are available. At SV, the following fields are available:

Dental	Oral Medicine & Radiology, Orthodontics & Dentofacial Orthopedics, Public Health Dentistry, Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery, Periodontology, Pedodontics & Preventive Dentistry, Prosthodontics, Crown & Bridge, Oral Pathology & Microbiology, Conservative Dentistry & Endodontic.

- (10) Calendar: EAIMS prefers to receive postgraduate candidates in 1 or 2 groups all over the year except in Ramadan time, whereas SV prefers to receive post graduate candidates during all the months except Dipawali holidays.
- (11) Certification: Both parties will issue a confirmation of academic training to each postgraduate candidate after completion of training.
- (12) Accommodation: Both parties will assist in locating suitable housing for the incoming postgraduate candidates. However, the parties are not responsible for any costs arising from accommodation. However, for incoming postgraduate candidates to SV, accommodation at University Guest House/Hostel shall be arranged on request as per policy of University.
- (13) Registration, Tuition Fees & Expenses: Postgraduate candidates will continue to be registered as per rules and criteria stipulated at their home university. Nominated postgraduate candidates do not have to pay any tuition fees to their host institution. The incoming postgraduate candidates are responsible for provision of any necessary insurance coverage, all expenses for insurance, travel, board and lodging, and other miscellaneous expenses as well as meeting all requirements associated with obtaining visa for the hosting country.

III. On the Faculty Member Level:

- (14) Each year, both institutions may exchange up to:
- 2 faculty members from Human Medicine,
 - 2 faculty members from Dental Medicine,
 - 2 faculty members from allied health sciences including Physiotherapy, Pharmacy, Nursing and Healthcare Management.
- up to 2 weeks where both institutes provide suitable academic teaching and/or research assignment to the guest faculty member.
- (15) Available fields: The available field are as mentioned in point no. 9.
- (16) Accommodation: Both parties will assist in locating suitable housing for the guest faculty member(s). However, the parties are not responsible for any costs arising from accommodation.
- (17) Certificate of Appreciation: Both parties will provide certificate of appreciation for valued contribution made by guest faculty member(s).

Administrative requirements:

- (18) Language: is English. All exchange candidates shall have a working knowledge of English in order to be eligible to participate in this program.
- (19) Selection & Eligibility: Both parties select and nominate the eligible exchange candidates and provide the partner institution with relevant information no later than 4 months prior to the supposed start of clerkship or training.

- (20) Relevant information about each exchange candidate should include:
- Application form with the participant's name as stated in the passport
 - Copy of passport showing number, validation, name and photo
 - CV and 2 photos
 - Motivation letter
 - Enrollment Certificate from his/her faculty
 - Recommendation letter from his/her faculty.
- (21) Visa: After receiving the applicants' packages, the hosting organization sends 2 copies of an official invitation letter for each receiving applicant via post and e-mail to firstly its embassy in the sending institution's country and secondly to the sending institution itself. The official invitation letter should contain the details of final acceptance in order to help each applicant to get the visa. However, the exchange candidates are responsible to meet all requirements to gain a visa of the hosting country and for all expenses arising from that.
- (22) Reception by the host institution: After getting the required visa, each applicant sends a notification by e-mail to the hosting institution containing the exact date, time and way of their arrival at least 2 weeks prior to the beginning of clerkship or training. Both parties prefer the participants to arrive in groups.
- (23) Intercultural Understanding: All exchange candidates should follow the morals and traditions of the hosting country and the hosting institution. To foster the understanding of differences in lifestyle and culture and subsequent expected behavior in the host country, each host institution provides the exchange candidates with information material and/or instructions prior to or at their arrival in the hosting country.
- (24) Expenses: The exchange candidates are responsible for the costs of their airplane tickets, accommodation, transportation, outings, and other miscellaneous expenses as well as the expenses of medical treatment if unfortunately necessary. Any company with the exchange candidate shall be responsible for their personal board and lodging.
- (25) Liability and Misbehaviour: Both parties expressly do not assume any liability for the misbehaviour or negligence of exchange candidates which are related in any way to this exchange program.

Miscellaneous:

- (26) Termination: This agreement shall be effective beginning with date of signature of both parties and shall continue in effect for three years unless one party provides written notification of termination to the other not less than ninety (90) days prior to termination date. The termination date is 30th September each year. Should this occur, the parties agree to carry out the terms of this agreement for any exchange candidate already nominated to the hosting institution.
- (27) Amendments: Other provisions may be added upon mutual agreement as an addendum to this agreement, provided all parties sign such an addendum. The parties submit proposals regarding the following year by October.
- (28) Each of the contracting parties will receive an original Letter of Agreement signed and stamped by both partners.




